

TICCIT CHECKLIST

- TREE SAPPLINGS**
You'll need to order tree saplings at least 3 weeks before you administer the program. We recommend at least one tree sapling per student to take home.
- SAPLING BOX**
You'll need a sapling box or empty milk carton for each sapling the students will take home to plant with their families.
- SOIL**
You'll want to have extra soil for the students to use to plant their saplings, approximately 1 medium-sized bag of soil for every 20-25 kids.
- CONTAINERS**
We've found that letting students scoop dirt from a large container or bucket in an assembly line fashion makes TICCIT events cleaner and more organized. You'll want 1 or 2 containers for every 20-25 students. Make sure to fill the dirt AFTER the container is put in place.
- INDOOR/OUTDOOR PLAN**
Weather permitting, TICCIT is a great exercise to host outside, in the grass or on pavement, weather permitting. Consider bringing newspaper or tarps if the weather doesn't allow you to host the event outside.
- PLANTING SUPPLIES**
Make sure to have small shovels or trowels for the students to scoop the dirt into their sapling box. You'll want 2 tools for every container.
- PHOTOS**
Make sure to designate a photographer to capture the special experience.
- PHOTO RELEASE**
Work with your organization to make sure that all students are permitted to be captured in photos and videos.
